

## CONSTITUTION OF BAR ASSOCIATION, AMLOH

### PREAMBLE :


That the members of the Bar Association, Amloh have unanimously resolved to adopt the following constitution of Bar Association, Amloh (here in after called as Association) and secure all its members for :-

Equality in Status, Opportunity of Expression and shall have the following allusions and tenets:

- a. Respect of law and promote the administration of law and justice.
- b. Foster respect for profession and keep up and patronize its dignity.
- c. Maintain just and Hon'ble relations between the members and create and incite the sense of relationship, harmony among the members.
- d. Sincere endeavour of eradicate corruption, bribery, toutism and other parameters.
- e. To work for the welfare of the advocates.
- f. Shall protect and safe guard the interest, rights and privileges of the members of the legal profession in general and members of the association in particulars.
- g. To promote the co-operation, understanding and better bondage between the Bar and the Bench.

### ELIGIBILITY :

1. Every person enrolled as an advocate under the Advocates Act. 1961 shall be eligible for the membership of the Association with the full house approval of the Bar Association.
2. That the member who has applied for the membership of the Bar should not have been disqualified by any Bar Association.
3. There should not have been charge of corruption, mis-conduct, expelled or terminated from the service, Moral turpitude or theft etc.
4. That an affidavit to this effect shall form part of the application.



PRECEDURE :

- a. Every aspirant for the membership of the Association shall hand over a written application personally to the secretary of the Association and the Secretary with the approval of the President shall admit him with an entry fee of Rs.500/- as subscription of the current month.
- b. That the enrollment number shall be specifically mentioned in the application accompanied by an attested copy of the certificate, the President shall thereupon enroll the aspirant after scrutinizing all documents as member of the Association.
- c. That the monthly subscription shall be Rs. 50/- per month subject to the variation from time to time by the association with mutual consent.
- d. That the collection shall be made by the duly authorized Office bearer cum cashier before the 15<sup>th</sup> of every month.
- e. That any member may pay the annual subscription in lump sum with other dues if any.
- f. That a member shall deemed to be in arrear who fails to pay the subscription continuously for six months.
- g. Any member whose name has been removed by the house for non payment of the arrears shall not be eligible for the membership of the Association unless he submits fresh application with entry fee of Rs. 500/- with all his/ her arrears subject to the approval by the General House.

OFFICE BEARERS :

- a. That the General House of the Association shall elect a Governing body of the Association every year by the 20<sup>th</sup> day of December every year and the Governing body shall be consisting of the President, Vice President, Secretary, Cashier.

- b. That any other additional member may be added to the Governing body by majority votes in General House meeting.
- c. That the term of the Governing Body shall be of one year starting from 1<sup>st</sup> of January till 31<sup>st</sup> December every year.

ELECTION & OTHER RULES & REGULATIONS:

1. That the Election of the Governing body of the Bar Association, Amloh shall be held on the 20<sup>th</sup> December Every year and in case the said date is holiday, the same shall be held on next working day without any further notice.
2. That the election process shall be as under:
  - a. Nominations ---- 14<sup>th</sup> December
  - b. Withdrawals ---- 15<sup>th</sup> December
  - c. Scrutiny ---- 16<sup>th</sup> December
  - d. Elections( if Necessary) ---- 20<sup>th</sup> DecemberNote : If on any of the date mentioned above falls holiday, the same shall be treated as next working day.
3. That the outgoing President shall be returning officer and in case of his absence, the Vice President shall conduct the Elections and in case any problem or controversy arises, any member of the Bar Association can be appointed as returning officer by the house.
4. That the nomination fees shall be as under :
  - a. President ---- Rs. 1000/-
  - b. Vice President ---- Rs. 750/-
  - c. Secretary ---- Rs. 750/-
  - d. Cashier ---- Rs. 500/-
  - e. That the nomination fee once deposited is non refundable even in case of withdrawal.

5. That the Election shall be held in the Bar Room, Amloh by secret ballot and each member shall have the right to cast one vote. No proxy

voting is permissible. The president shall have the right of Casting Vote in case of dispute arises.

6. That the Voter List of the Bar shall be prepared by the President and the Secretary by the last day of November and shall be displayed on the notice board and the objections, if any, shall be cleared by the 5<sup>th</sup> of December every.
7. That every member shall clear his dues by the 25<sup>th</sup> day of Novembers till 4 PM and failing which he shall be deemed to be defaulter and shall not be entitled to Vote.
8. That any member enrolled after 30<sup>th</sup> November shall not be eligible for vote for that year.
9. That the annual meeting of Full House of the Bar Association, Amloh shall held on the 20<sup>th</sup> of December after the declaration of the results of the Elections to constitute the next Governing Body.
10. That quorum of 2/3<sup>rd</sup> members of the Bar shall be required for the Annual General Meeting of the Full House. The Balance Sheet/ Accounts and the report of the association shall be placed before the full House.
11. That the President and the Secretary are authorized to call urgent / emergency meeting of the full house or the Governing body as and when required to discuss any urgent matter and all the matter shall be adopted with the majority votes.
12. That minutes of every meeting shall be recorded by the Secretary and the minutes so recorded shall be signed by the President.
13. That the amendment to the Constitution can be done by the General House meeting with majority of 2/3<sup>rd</sup> members and such amendment shall form the part of the original constitution.
14. That the House may time to time appoint Committees / sub committees by simple majority for special purpose subject to the approval of their opinion by the 2/3<sup>rd</sup> majority of the full house.
15. That this constitution shall repeal all other decisions of the Bar taken in contravention of the rules mentioned herein.

16. That the No-Confidence motion against the Governing body can be brought by the 2/3<sup>rd</sup> majority of the house.

17. That this constitution is adopted on this 29<sup>th</sup> day of the September 2009 at Amloh.
